Instructions for online signup:

- 1. Go to the Universal Church Directories website (www.ucdir.com)
- 2. Click on the box on the right side of the homepage entitled "photography appointment scheduling login"
- 3. Enter your church code: ia233
- 4. Enter your church password: photos
- 5. Click on the Enter button
- 6. Click on the desired photography date
- 7. Click on the Reserve Time button beside the desired photography appointment time
- 8. Enter the appropriate information in all required fields
- 9. Click on the Schedule Appointment button at the bottom of the screen to reserve the photography appointment time in your family's name
- 10. If you have more than six family members being photographed, please reserve two appointments consecutively (such as 6:00 and 6:10)
- 11. Print the next screen to use as a reminder of your family's photography appointment
- 12. Contact the church office to change or cancel your photography appointment

Back to School Month

Saying goodbye to summer and transitioning into a new school year can be a difficult time for many adolescents, especially those with emotional or behavioral disorders. LSI has 27 therapists that provide mental health counseling to individuals of all ages through in-person therapy in over 20 locations across the state and virtual therapy in all 99 counties. In 2022, our Clinical Services team served more than 1,000 clients, totaling 14,000+ therapy sessions for Iowans of all ages.


In addition, our Behavioral Health Intervention Services team wraps care around a child's entire family to empower them with skills like anger management, healthy decision-making and problemsolving. In 2022, the BHIS team served over 250 clients, resulting in more than 3,900 therapy sessions for children and their families.

Through LSI's Trauma Informed Care program at the Juvenile Detention Center in Waterloo, our staff work with the teens by completing trauma assessments on each adolescent and providing a summary to their juvenile court officers. The LSI staff also facilitate both individual and group therapy sessions with the teens to help them deal with their trauma and work through it in a productive way.
