Saint John Lutheran Church Pastoral Call Committee Update for the Caller 03-20-2024

Your Pastoral Call committee has been very busy carrying out what I refer to as the "pre-work," of the call process. We began meeting in October. Early on a meeting with Pastor Judith Johnson was held via "Zoom." Pastor Johnson is the Synod representative that coordinates Pastoral call processes. She educated our committee as well as the Church Council members on the call process according to the Synod guidelines.

In December the congregational forums were conducted and the results were documented and discussed. The congregation indicated the call needed to be for a new Senior Pastor.

In January and February we have been preparing the Ministry Site Profile (MSP). This is a thirteen page document used as a recruitment tool by the Synod and us to showcase our church and our congregation. It is a lengthy and detailed document that must be approved by our Church Council and the Synod.

In February and March we prepared and launched a separate survey to be completed by the congregation to further determine what characteristics best define our church as well as the person we will ultimately call as our next Senior Pastor

Still to come: we must achieve approval of the MSP by the Council of St. John (hopefully this will happen at the March Council meeting) and the Western Iowa Synod. Once approval is given the MSP will be posted on-line through the Synod office and the actual Call process will begin. The profiles of candidates will be received and reviewed by the committee. The best candidates will be brought in for interviews and, once the call committee selects a candidate, his or her name will be voted on by the council. The council, then in turn, will present the candidate to the congregation for a vote to issue a call to that pastor.

It is important for you to know that our MSP will be including an outline for the transition plan. This plan will include some of the steps of allowing Pastor Jon to gradually move all of the parts of his ministry to our new Pastor. This will also allow our new Pastor to more easily assume all of the essential aspects of the ministry at St. John as well as identify opportunities for the initiation of the new person's ministry that may be different from what we currently experience. With an end point identified Pastor Jon will step away and our new Pastor will continue on. We ask for your prayers as we strive to discern where God is leading us in this process and for us to be able to bring a new Pastor to our service that will continue to lead St. John forward as God has planned. If you know a Pastor who might be interested in this position, have them go to the Western Iowa Synod website and fill out an application.





SHARE THE WORD: Pastor's discretionary account at work -

Many of you in the congregation contribute to Pastor's discretionary account. Some of you probably don't know that you do, but all 'loose' money in the collection plate on the first of each month gets deposited into that account as well as other designated contributions. Pastor puts the money to good use helping people in our community with rent, energy bills, gas, and groceries.

In January, Pastor also sent some funds to our neighbors in the Nebraska Synod who specifically work with people to build homes for the poor in Tanzania. Below is a report of the recipient of this home.

1/28/2024

Pastor Jon and all at St John Council Bluffs, Salaam.

This is Bob Kasworm at Machame Lutheran Hospital in Kilimanjaro Tanzania.

I received a report from the Nebraska Synod regarding a kind donation from St John's to build a House for Health in Tanzania.

We recently began your house...which will be House #186 in this long running program.

The recipients of your home are Simbo Martin Swai a widower of age 63 and his two daughters Hollyness 10 and Gertruda 16. They live in the Machame subvillage of Masoma Mbosho. The wife died some ten years ago from leukemia. Mr Swai has a severe asthmatic condition. As the pictures of their current house below show, their need for improved shelter is great.

To get started, we met with the family, clan elders, neighbors, village/church leaders and others who all all signed a document stating that when we build a house on this site for this family, it will belong to them. We then signed a contract with our builder who uses all local labor, including that from the nearby neighborhood, and 100% Tanzanian materials.

This house will be a sign to the family and community that through God someone cares, that good things can happen, and there is hope. In this case especially, having a better house will likely attract extended family to assist Simbo far into the future.

We have had several months of rain (unusual at this time of year) but building conditions are improving and we are making good progress. You will hear from me again with pictures of the finished house in about a month. Thank you for thinking of the very poor in Tanzania.

We have finished your House for Health for Mr Simbo Swai and his daughters. As the attached pictures show, this will be quite an improvement. We are entering into our long rainy season and a dry, solid house will make a real difference in their lives.
